He has been honored for the 10th year in a row as one of America's Top 100 Educators in Continuing Dental Education. Along with Dr. Martin, he is currently conducting research on the connection of cardiac and periodontal disease and is president of the Institute of Advanced Oral/Physical Health, Bryn Mawr, Pa.

Dr. Martin has been in private practice in Philadelphia for more than 25 years. He is currently Chief of Interventional Cardiology and Dept. of Cardiology, Main Line Hospitals, Inc., Bryn Mawr, Pa. He is currently Assoc. Professor of Clinical Medicine, Thomas Jefferson Univ. and is a fellow of the American College of Cardiology, European Society of Cardiology and the Society of Cardiac Angiography and Intervention. He has published and presented 75 papers on cardiovascular problems and is the principal investigator in the Institute of Advanced Oral/Physical Health research study on the connection of cardiac and periodontal disease.
